RULES of 23rd INTERNATIONAL ART CONTEST

”PEOPLE DOOMED PEOPLE TO THIS FATE”

named after August Kowalczyk

I. Aims of competition:

- to disseminate the historical truth about Auschwitz-Birkenau and the Holocaust,
- to commemorate Victims and cultivate respect for nations which experienced the mass murder,
- fine art reflections of young participants inspired by words of Zofia Nałkowska “people doomed people to this fate”.

II. Subject matter of this year’s edition:

“CHILDHOOD IN A STRIPED CAMP UNIFORM”

1. Situation of children and their families in the camp reality.
2. Childhood in Auschwitz – based on the book “Childhood in a striped camp uniform” by Bogdan Bartnikowski.
3. Child – current images of enslavement.

III. Organizers

The Auschwitz-Birkenau State Museum in Oswiecim, The Kossak Family Artists Youth Culture Centre No 1 in Tychy.

IV. Co-organizers

The Auschwitz Commemoration and Welfare Association in Katowice, The City Hall of Tychy and the Institute of National Remembrance in Katowice.

V. Terms and conditions of competition

1. The competition is for children and young people participating in activity clubs organized by various institutions and students from all types of schools.
2. Age groups: 11 - 21 years old.
3. Technique: free (excluding glass painting), including photography and computer graphics.
4. Sizes of works: engraving A-4 or A-3, painting, drawing, collage, tapestry (max 50 x 70 cm).
5. Works should be without frames in passe-partout. Collective works are not accepted.
6. Clear full particulars (prepared on computer and glued on the reverse of the work)
 - a. Title of the work
 - b. Name, surname and age of the author;
 - c. Institution (name, full address, telephone number with dialling code number and e-mail address);
 - d. Name and surname of the teacher-instructor.
7. **Works of art will be accepted for the competition after paying entrance fee of 45 PLN for Polish participants or 10 EURO for foreign participants to the following account:**

VII. Jury

Jury session: **17. 02. 2021** The Competition Commission will consist of the invited former prisoners of the Auschwitz-Birkenau camp, artists of fine arts, historians and researchers of the Auschwitz-Birkenau State Museum and the Institute of National Remembrance in Katowice.

VIII. Final of the competition

The official announcement of the results, prize giving ceremony and opening of the post-competition exhibition, concert and snack will be held on **March 15th, 2021 at 10:30** at Teatr Maly and at Youth Culture Centre No 1 in Tychy, St. Hlonda 1.

The participants will be informed about the results of the competition by phone, letter, or e-mail. After the ceremony, the departure to Auschwitz memorial site is planned.

IX. Personal data:

1. Youth Culture Centre No 1 in Tychy, City Council in Tychy and City Culture Centre in Tychy, State Museum Auschwitz-Birkenau are personal data controllers (called Controllers – Administrator in Polish) in accordance with Regulation of the European Parliament and EU Council 2016/679 from 27. 04. 2016 on the free movement of such data and the repeal of the directive 95/46/WE.
2. Taking part in the competition is voluntary and means the acceptance of the rules of data processing for the purpose of the competition including the publication of: the work of art and its reproductions, the name and surname of the contestant and the results.
3. Personal data will be processed only during the competition and during works of art exhibition.
4. Contestants have the right to access their personal data, modification of data, corrections or deletion or limitation of their processing or data transfer, the right to object to data processing and the right to make complaints to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office in Poland.
5. Personal data will not be sent to countries and organisations outside the EU and will not be profiled.

X. Additional remarks:

1. All sent works become the organizer's property and can be used for archive, research and exhibition purposes.
2. The organizers reserve the right to reproduce chosen works free of charge.
3. The jury decision is decisive (a verdict without right of appeal).
4. The organizers do not return costs of transport, food and accommodation. The organizers can help participants to arrange food and accommodation, but the participants cover the cost on their own.
5. Certificates will be sent to the winners by post. The awards should be collected in person until 20th April 2021 in Youth Culture Centre No 1 in Tychy. It is possible to send them via post but the cost will be covered by the participant in such case (it will be earlier discussed with the organiser).
